

## **CMDv/ NOTICE TO APPLICANTS SUB-GROUP**

### **BACKGROUND**

The Veterinary Coordination Group (CMD(v)) has been established in accordance with Article 31.1 of Directive 2001/82/EC<sup>1</sup>. The tasks of the CMD(v) include giving guidance on the administrative aspects of procedures for Marketing Authorisations in the Mutual Recognition and Decentralised Procedures.

Guidance on these issues is also given in the Commission Eudralex collection of Notice to Applicants.

The Commission Working Party on the Notice to Applicants deals with both human and veterinary issues. The discussion at the meetings is mostly focused on issues concerning procedures for human medicinal products.

Many CMD(v) members are also members of the above mentioned Working Party.

### **MANDATE**

The mandate of the CMD(v) Sub-group on Notice to Applicants is :

1. To be a forum for members of both CMD(v) and the Notice to Applicants Working Party to discuss veterinary specific issues of Notice to Applicants.
2. In order to avoid duplication of work, to facilitate the preparation of veterinary Notice to Applicants guidance documents, utilising the expertise of members belonging to both above mentioned groups
3. To be a forum for discussions with the Commission on veterinary specific issues of Notice to Applicants

1. A coordination group shall be set up for the examination of any question relating to marketing authorisation of a veterinary medicinal product in two or more Member States in accordance with the procedures laid down in this Chapter.
